- Multi-unit Buildings:** Use a central rack chassis to manage incoming signals, distributing them via multimode fiber to individual floors or offices.

Network Architectures

- Passive Optical Network (PON):** Uses splitters to share a single fiber among multiple subscribers, reducing fiber and equipment costs.
- Active Star / Point-to-Point (P2P):** Each subscriber has a dedicated fiber link to the CO, requiring more fiber but offering higher bandwidth and simpler troubleshooting.
