Residual Current Devices (RCDs) or leakage protection switches are installed here to prevent electrical hazards, forming the second layer of protection.
- Tertiary Distribution Box (Level 3):** The final junction box connected to individual electrical appliances or equipment. It can be fixed or portable and includes leakage protection switches for each device, ensuring that each appliance has independent protection. This level enforces the principle of “one machine, one switch, one RCD, one box, one lock”, preventing multiple devices from being controlled by a single switch.

- Outdoor Suitability:** Boxes are often rainproof and UV-resistant, complying with IP65–IP68 standards for outdoor installations.
