

The distribution box should be installed several meters off the ground



Overview

In homes, the best height for installation is about 1. The distribution box should be installed in an area close to the power supply to reduce power loss and ensure safety. Avoid installing in a humid and corrosive environment to prevent equipment damage. This helps prevent electrical problems and makes maintenance easier. This height setting fully considers the ergonomic characteristics of operators, allowing routine maintenance work such as switch operation. 3) The distribution box shall be installed firmly, horizontally and vertically, and the vertical deviation shall not be greater than 3mm; During concealed installation, there should be no gap around the distribution box, the edge around the panel should be close to the wall, and the contact part. The IEC (International Electrotechnical Commission) and BS 7671 (British Standard for Electrical Installations) both provide essential requirements for electrical installations, including those for fuse boards like garage unit, consumer unit and distribution board.
