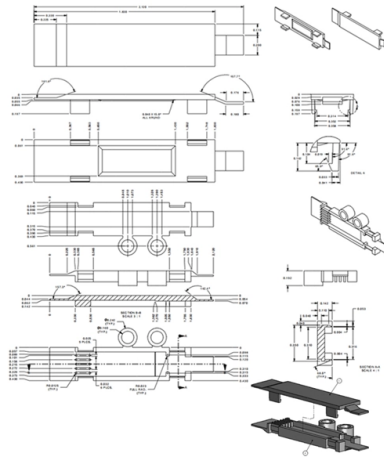

- Reorganize Existing Circuits:** In some cases, redistributing circuits or removing unused breakers can free up space. However, this requires careful planning to avoid overloading any circuit.
