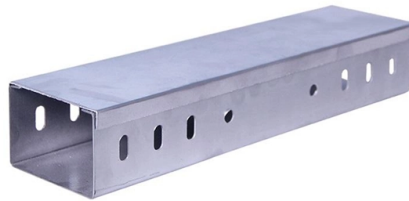

Repairing a cut involves locating the damage, splicing the fibers, and restoring service, which can take hours or longer depending on the extent of the damage and terrain. Understanding these causes helps operators implement preventive measures, such as better cable protection, surveillance, and coordination with construction projects, to minimize disruptions and maintain network reliability.
