The grounding pin is not electrically connected to the device yoke, and, so, not connected to the metallic outlet box. It is therefore “isolated” from the green wire ground.

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DISTRIBUTION BOX

Each DISTRIBUTION BOX and controller must be grounded. On the US market, a 5.26 mm² (10 AWG) ground wire must be used, and in all other markets a 6 mm² must be used.
