

The number of electrical distribution box levels should not exceed number

Generally, the number of low-voltage distribution levels should not exceed three, as too many levels can result in poor power supply reliability. Boxes located on opposite sides of walls or partitions shall be separated by a horizontal distance of 24 inches. The metallic outlet or switch boxes shall be securely.
