Consider span length and support spacing when selecting thickness; closer supports allow thinner trays, while longer unsupported spans require thicker trays. For light industrial setups, channel or wire mesh trays are often preferred due to ease of installation and flexibility for small cable bundles. By selecting the appropriate thickness based on load, span, and environment, light industrial cable trays can provide reliable, safe, and long-lasting cable management.
