In a horizontal box configuration, busbars and distribution blocks are arranged horizontally, usually at the top or bottom of the enclosure. This layout allows:

- Efficient cabling and reduced wiring complexity.
- Flexible placement of input and output terminals.
- Space-saving design in XL³ or similar enclosures, supporting ratings from 400 A up to 6300 A.
- Ease of maintenance, as horizontal busbars provide clear access to connections and terminal blocks.

Legrand's HX³ horizontal distribution system exemplifies this approach, offering robust cabinets with copper or aluminum busbars, isolating supports, and terminal blocks for high-power outputs.

Installation and Safety Considerations

When installing a three-level horizontal distribution box, follow these key guidelines:

- Distance limits:** Distribution boards should be within 30 meters of the switch box, and the horizontal distance to controlled equipment should ideally be ≤ 3 meters.
