Wiring to the Distribution Box

Main connection: Connect the two hot wires to the main breaker or designated terminals in the distribution box. Ensure they are on opposite phases to provide 240V across the load.

Neutral connection: In a 3-wire subpanel, the neutral is bonded to the panel enclosure and serves as the return path for current. In modern 4-wire setups, the neutral is isolated from the panel and connected to a separate neutral bar.

Grounding: If using a 3-wire system, the neutral also acts as the ground. For safety, ensure the panel is properly bonded to a grounding rod or system. In 4-wire systems, connect the ground wire to a dedicated grounding bar.

Secure connections: Use appropriate terminals, clamps, and cable gauges based on the expected load. For residential setups, 10 AWG is common for hot wires and 12 AWG for neutral, but always verify local code requirements.
