- QSFP-DD/OSFP: 400G–800G, designed for high-density AI and hyperscale data center fabrics, supporting liquid cooling and high power consumption (Arista XPO, Cisco OSFP).

DML Technology: Provides reliable modulation for single-mode fiber links, often integrated with diagnostic monitoring for performance and reliability.

Warranty and Reliability Many manufacturers of pluggable optical modules, including Cisco, GIGALIGHT, and Acacia, provide extended warranties of up to three years for enterprise and carrier-grade modules. These warranties typically cover:

- Defects in materials and workmanship
- Performance compliance with specified data rates and distances
- Replacement or repair in case of failure within the warranty period

Extended warranties are particularly important for high-density deployments where downtime can be costly, and modules are expected to operate reliably under liquid-cooled or immersion environments (GIGALIGHT, Aris...
