Cable ampacity may need to be de-rated due to the deeper stacking of cables, especially when different circuits are combined.
3. Structural Support Vertical trays must be mounted on cantilever brackets, wall supports, or threaded rod suspensions capable of handling the combined weight of both rows of cables. Supports should be placed near joints and bends (≤ 150 mm from joints) to maintain stability and prevent sagging.
4. Compliance and Safety Installations should comply with standards such as DIN EN 61537 for cable support systems. Materials like steel or stainless steel with galvanization are recommended for corrosion resistance, particularly in industrial environments. Covers or barriers may be used to protect cables from mechanical damage or environmental exposure.
