They come in various types like SC, LC, ST, and MTP, each designed for specific. The function of fiber optic connectors is to align and connect two or more fibers together to provide a means for attaching to, or decoupling from, a transmitter, receiver, or any other fiber optic component. The connectors can be put on patchcords, pigtailed or components with single-mode (SM). Plastic optical fiber (POF) cables are made from light-conducting plastics, polymers, and acrylics, are typically used for short, low-speed data links and illumination, and are renowned for their ease of installation, low cost, and flexibility.
