Multiple screw terminals can be arranged in the form of a barrier strip, with a number of short metal strips separated by a raised insulated "barrier" on an insulating "block" – each strip having a pair of screws with each screw connecting to a separate conductor, one at each end of the strip. These are known as "connector strips" or "chocolate blocks" ("choc blocks") in the UK. This nickname arises from the first such connector
