Aerial fiber optic cable is a type of optical fiber transmission cable used for aerial deployment, suspended on towers, poles, or other supports, suitable for communication needs spanning long distances and connecting different areas. It provides stable, high-speed optical signal transmission across long distances and complex terrains. Aerial fiber optic cables are commonly used in optical communications and are now so common that they can be seen on utility poles all around you. Aerial work mixes mechanical engineering (span, sag, tension), careful selection of cable types (ADSS, figure-8, lashed) and a disciplined safety-first attitude. Ribbon cables offer higher fiber counts and greater fiber density than any other cable construction designed for the outside plant (OSP), up to eight times the highest-fiber-count loose tube cable.
