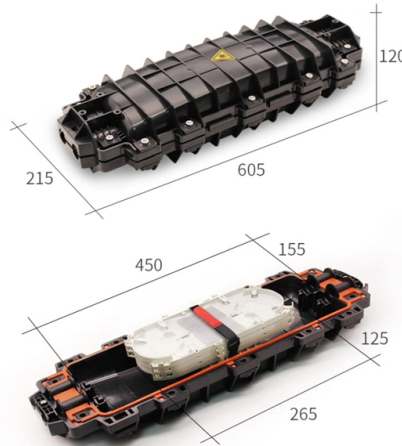


What wires should be selected for installing a distribution box

- Maintain neat cable management using cable ties or channels to prevent short circuits and facilitate maintenance.
- Ensure proper insulation and avoid exposed copper to reduce fire risk.
- Label all wires clearly for easy identification during inspection or future upgrades.
- Follow local electrical codes (NEC, IEC, or regional standards) and use certified components (UL/CE) for safety.
