Enclosure and Components The distribution box consists of an outer shell and internal electrical components. The enclosure protects against environmental hazards, while inside you will find circuit breakers, busbars, terminal blocks, and wiring. Choose materials based on the environment: steel for durability in harsh conditions and plastic for indoor use. Ensure the enclosure has sufficient capacity for current wiring and future expansion.

Wiring Specifications

Power Off: Always disconnect the main supply before wiring.

Wire Type: Use high-temperature resistant copper wires with cross-sectional areas suitable for the load.

Connections: Follow the principle: phase wire to phase terminal, neutral to neutral terminal, ground to ground terminal.

Neatness: Arrange wires neatly, secure with ties, and avoid exposed copper to prevent short circuits.

Testing: Perform insulation and continuity tests using a multimeter before powering on.

Protective Devices

Main MCB: Acts as the main switch; typically a double-pole MCB rated according to the total load.

Output MCBs: Single-pole or double-pole MCBs for individual circuits.
