

Wiring method of primary power distribution box on construction site

Protective Devices: Incoming lines are connected through MCCBs, circuit breakers, or knife switches. The neutral line is pressed to the neutral terminal block, and the grounding wire is connected to the grounding terminal block.

Installation Considerations

Height and Location: The bottom edge of the distribution box is typically installed 1.5–1.8 meters above ground for easy operation and inspection. The site should be dry, well-ventilated, and away from corrosive or humid environments to prevent overheating and equipment damage.

Fixing Method: Use firm mounting brackets or screws to prevent movement or tilting due to vibration or accidental impact.

Cable Management: Ensure all cable inlets and cover joints are sealed properly, and wire numbers are clearly identified to avoid confusion and exposure.

Safety Measures

Grounding: The metal box, electrical installation board, and all metallic parts inside must be properly grounded.
